

BIKE RENTAL POLICIES

The person renting a bicycle is obliged to subject to all terms and condition of this agreement:

1. Only the students of International Faculty of Engineering are allowed to rent a bicycle.
2. The person renting a bicycle is responsible financially for any damage imposed on the bicycle, its loss as well as the theft committed by a third person.
3. The rent of bicycle must be preceded by a prior booking using either mail correspondence or by contacting a member of ESN-EYE at the Students Organisations Room, in front of Aula IFE.
4. The minimum period of time for which a bicycle may be rented is a week, while the maximum rental time is the entire year.
5. Renting a bicycle is FREE OF CHARGE, however a person interested will have to participate in the cost of maintenance of the bicycle, which includes periodical service.
6. When renting a bicycle, a student is obliged to pay a deposit of 400 PLN (about 100EUR), which is given back on the day of returning the bike, supposing that the bicycle is not damaged. On such occasion the returned deposit is reduced, depending on what has been broken. Prices of new parts: inner tube of a bicycle tyre: 15PLN, tyre: 40PLN, chain 30PLN, breaks 35PLN, regulation of wheels 15-30PLN, regulation of gears 15PLN. Prices of other parts will be evaluated according to the price list of the Maxxbike shop. On the occasion of a late return of the bike, without prior information, the price for each prolonged day will be 5PLN.
7. On renting a bicycle, student is to fill a formulae including: acceptance of the rental policies, leave of deposit, initial state of the bicycle, evaluated together with the person giving out the bicycle, student's ID number and their signature. The return state is examined on delivery of the bike. In addition, a photo is taken of the student and the rented bicycle.
8. The rented bicycle may only be used by the designated student.
9. The student is obliged to lock the bicycle, at all times when unattended, with the security chain provided with the bicycle.
10. Prolonging keeping of the bike, without informing members of ESN-EYE, followed by lack of the contact with a student borrowing the bicycle will be treated as theft. This, afterwards, will be reported to the Police and the Court.
